Orange Grove:

PSP supports Orange Grove which is a flexible workspace and pre-incubator for young entrepreneurs aspiring to become a catalyst for the development and growth of the startup ecosystem in Greece.

Proof of Concept:

The aim of the program is to annually support 10 scientific / research ideas, up to € 50,000 each, to mature and commercially exploit products by scientists or to create new enterprise

Industrial Property Organization: PSP hosts the Industrial Property Organization Regional Sub-Offices which operates as a local contact point for IP protection, Patents at National and International level etc.





CERN's Business Innovation Center (BIC): PSP is the entry point of CERN in Greece with the aim to provide support to new entrepreneurs to exploit technologies developed by CERN and to create new products and services.
