Synergies with Clean Sky 2 and ESIF

- **Synergies and complementarity**, an opportunity for all participants, whatever their size and role in the Innovation Chain
- Opportunity for **significant support** to the supply chain, SMEs, Clusters (active in Clean Sky or planning to apply)
- **Strategic opportunity** for linking their OPs and funding schemes to Clean Sky 2 and implement projects in synergy
- Synergies with ESIF is one of the **highlighted recommendations** from the European Commission's High-Level Group, chaired by Pascal Lamy.

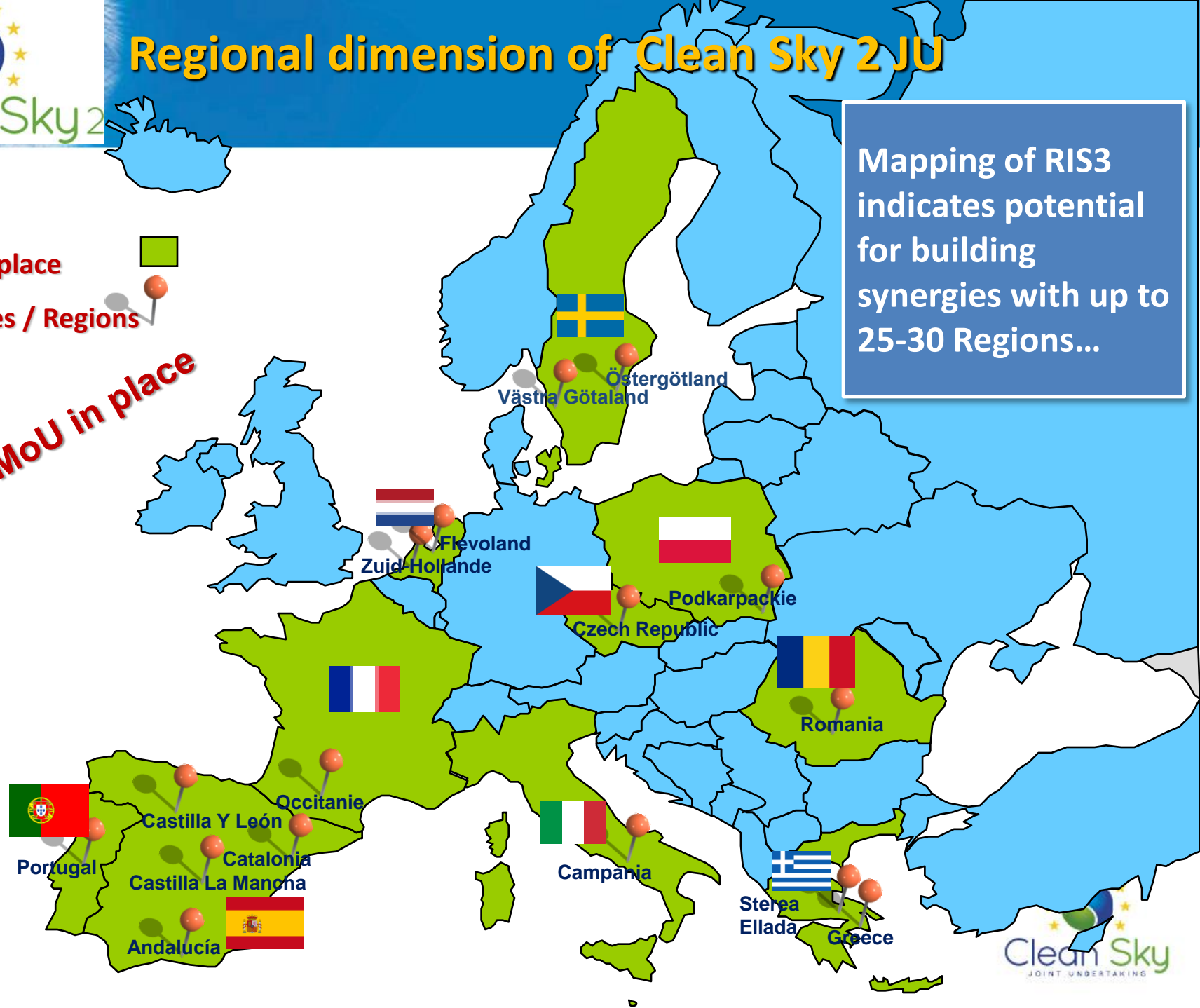

Clean Sky 2 cooperation with M-S/ Regions: objectives

- Contribute to enhance European dimension of “Aeronautics Regions” and Regions willing to invest in the sector *“think global – act local”*
- Bring together more MS/regions which are interested in investing in aeronautics and other related technologies
- Bring together the SMEs and the national/regional Clean Sky Leaders/Core Partners, through complementary ESIF proposals to CS2JU programmes
- Leverage effect from synergies between ESIF, EU Programmes and other National/Regional funds



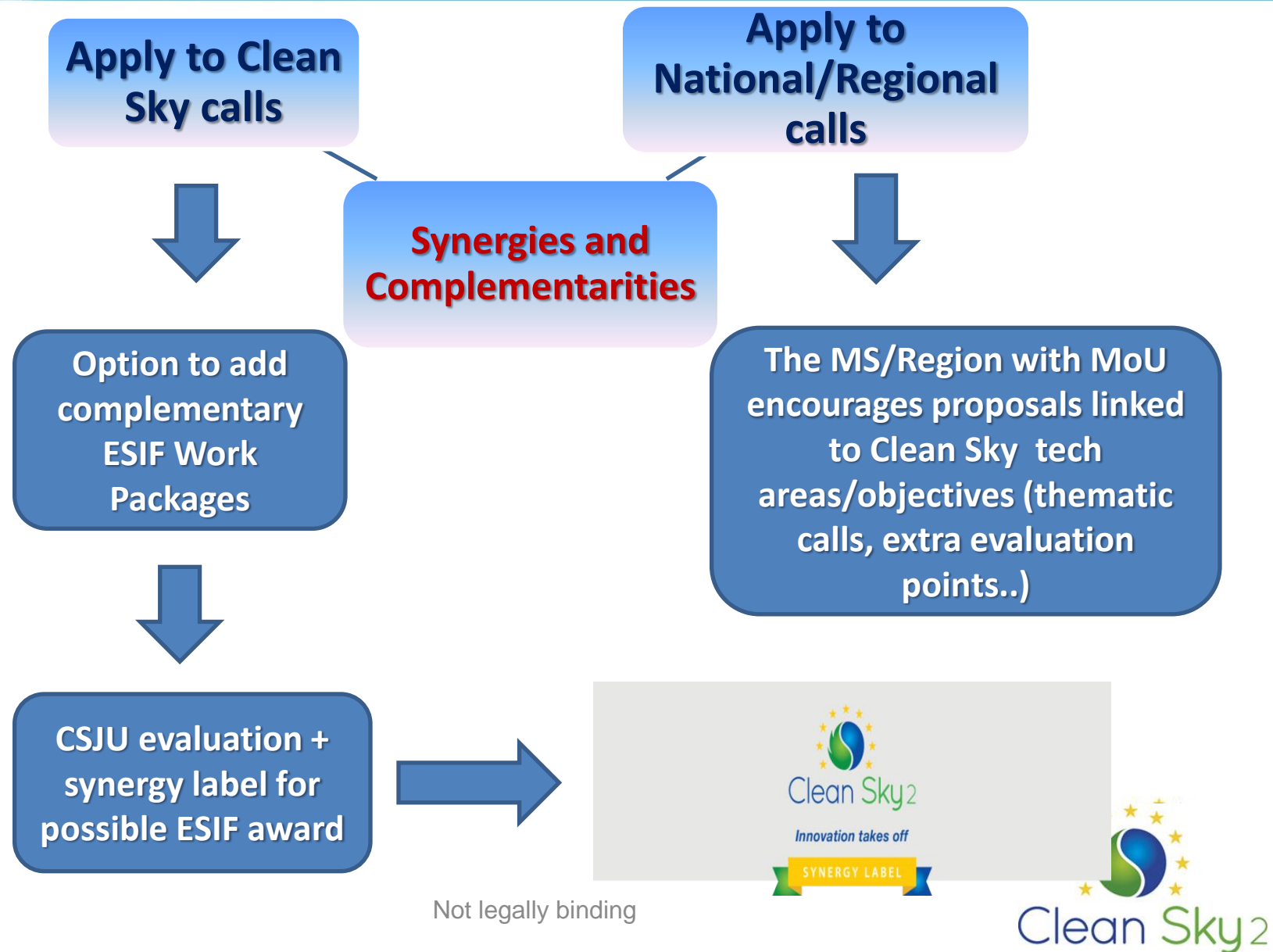
MoU objectives and implementation

- MS/Regions take a commitment to support the cooperation with Clean Sky and to plan/design ESIF funded schemes to support complementarities
- Identify within a WG, areas of technical cooperation with national/regional stakeholders in line with RIS3
- Support through ESIF/Regional funds complementary activities not covered by Clean Sky scope but contributing to its objectives and with a market potential
- Support regional stakeholders/SMEs on information days, networking and participation to Clean Sky calls
- Support the State/Region in the technical assessment of complementarities for ESIF/Regional support via labels” certifications

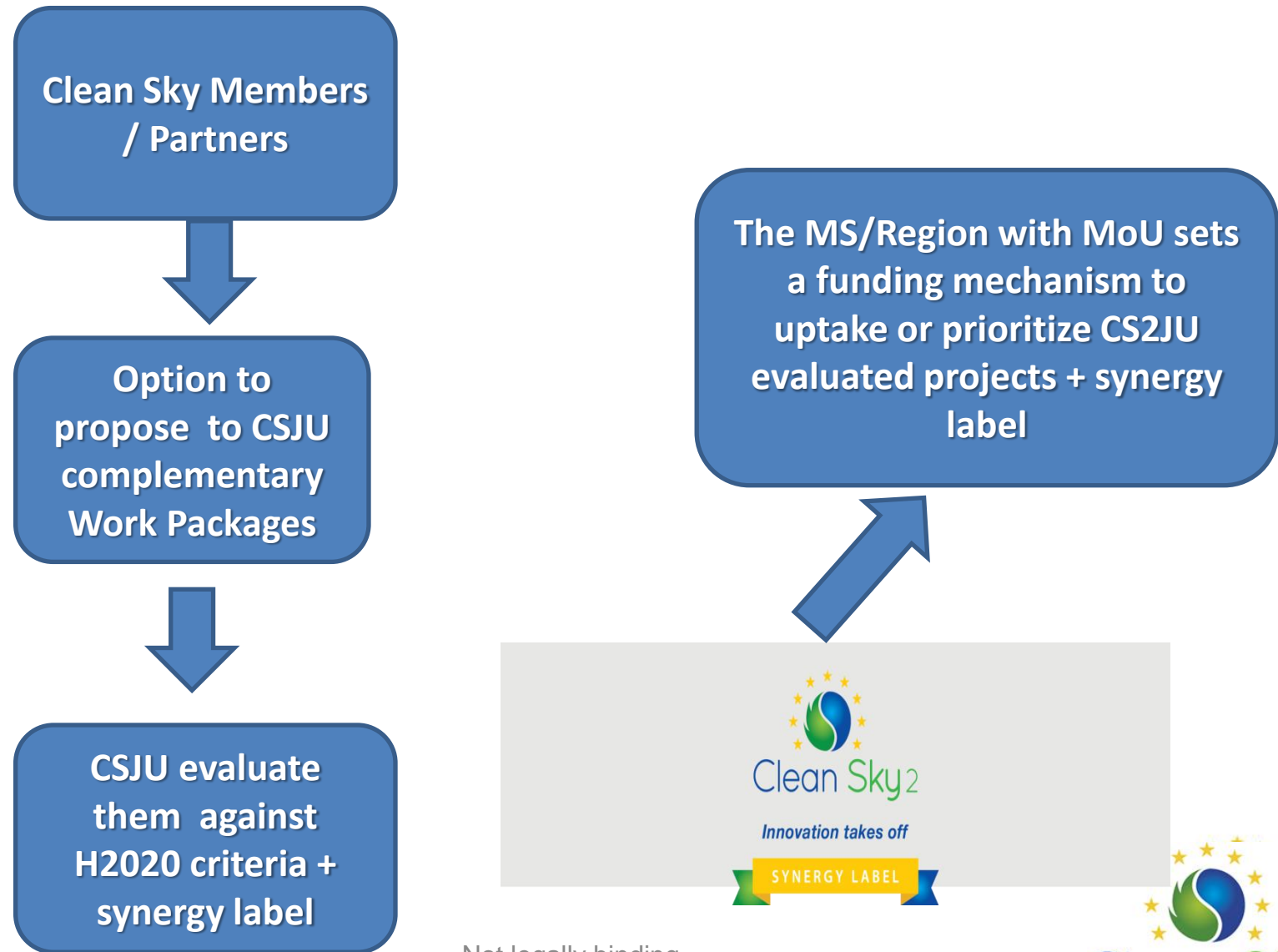

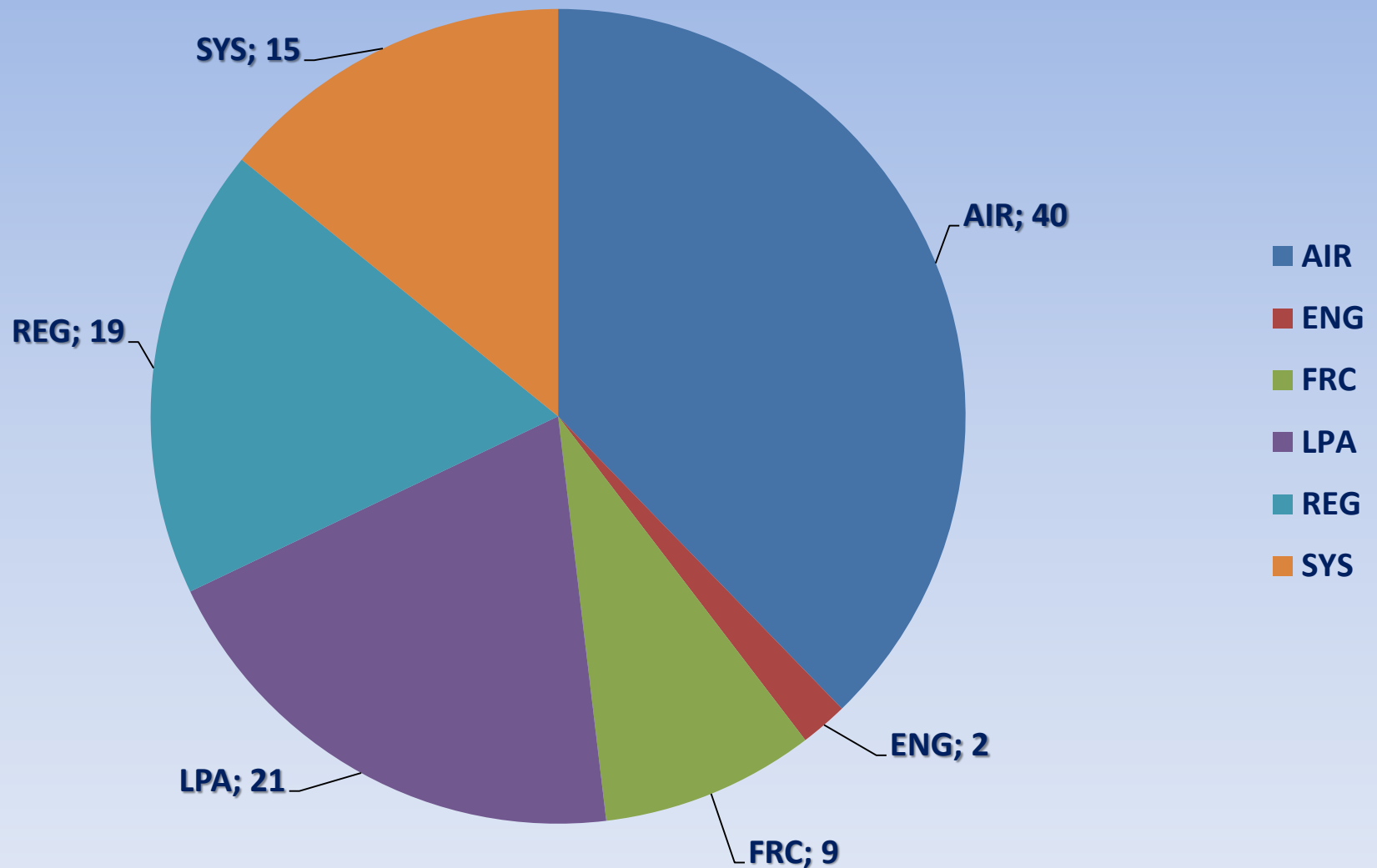

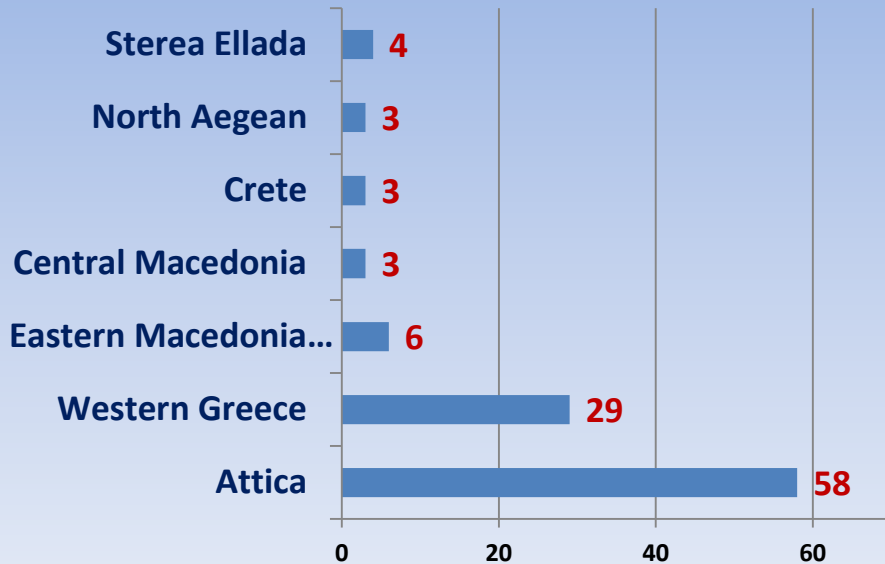
Greece's participation in CS2 calls (I)

Breakdown of Greece's participation in CS2 ITD/IADPs

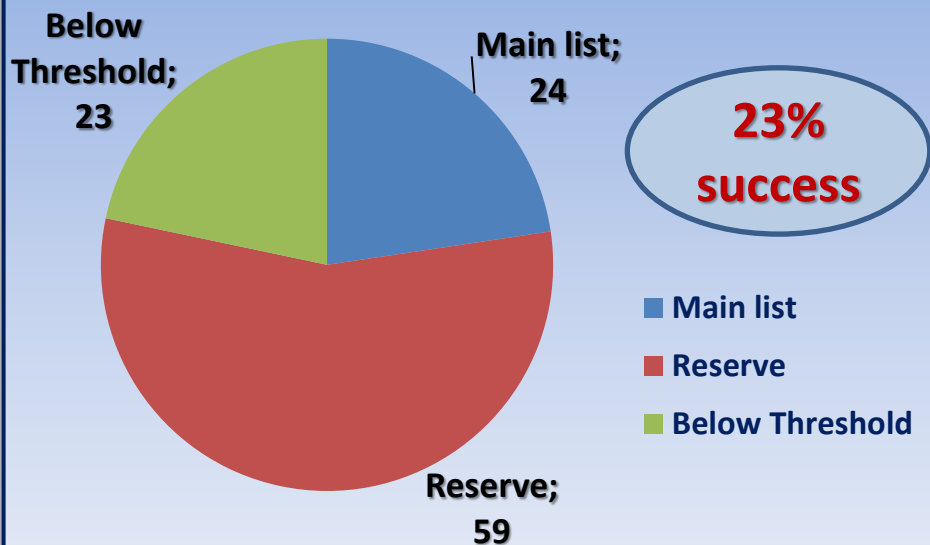
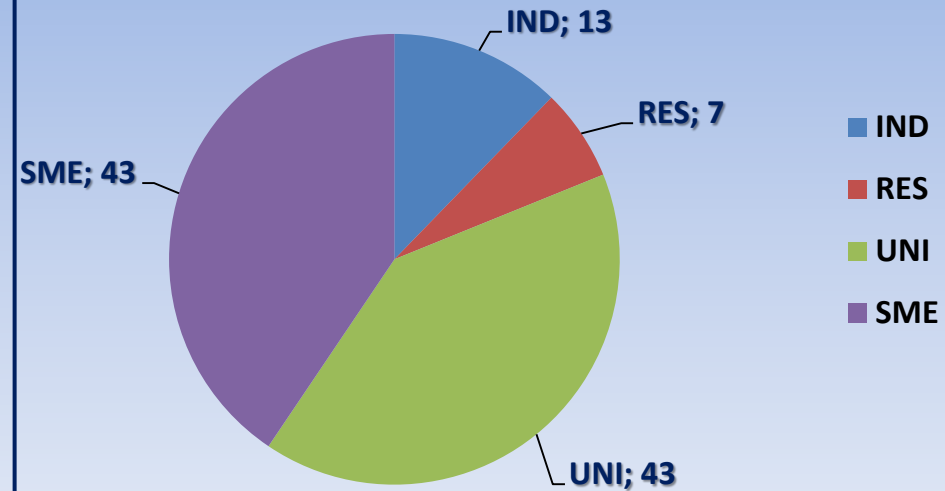

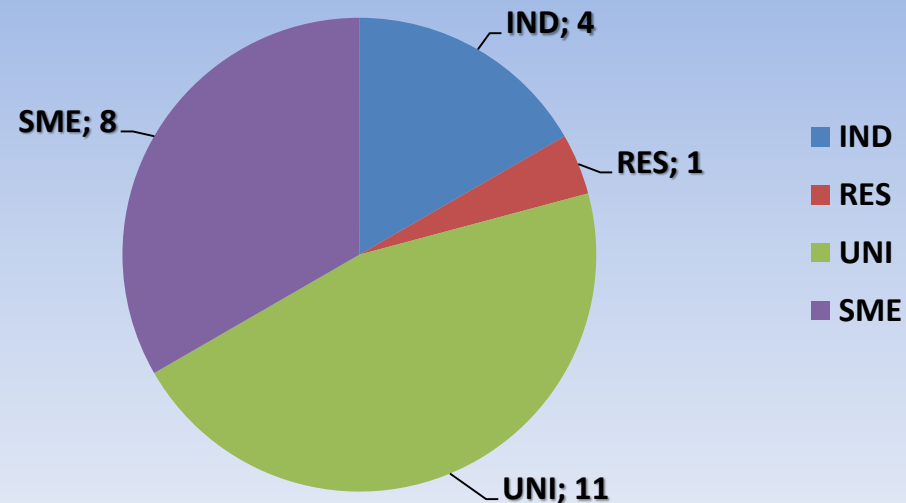
Breakdown of Regions' participation



Breakdown of participating organisations in CS 2 calls

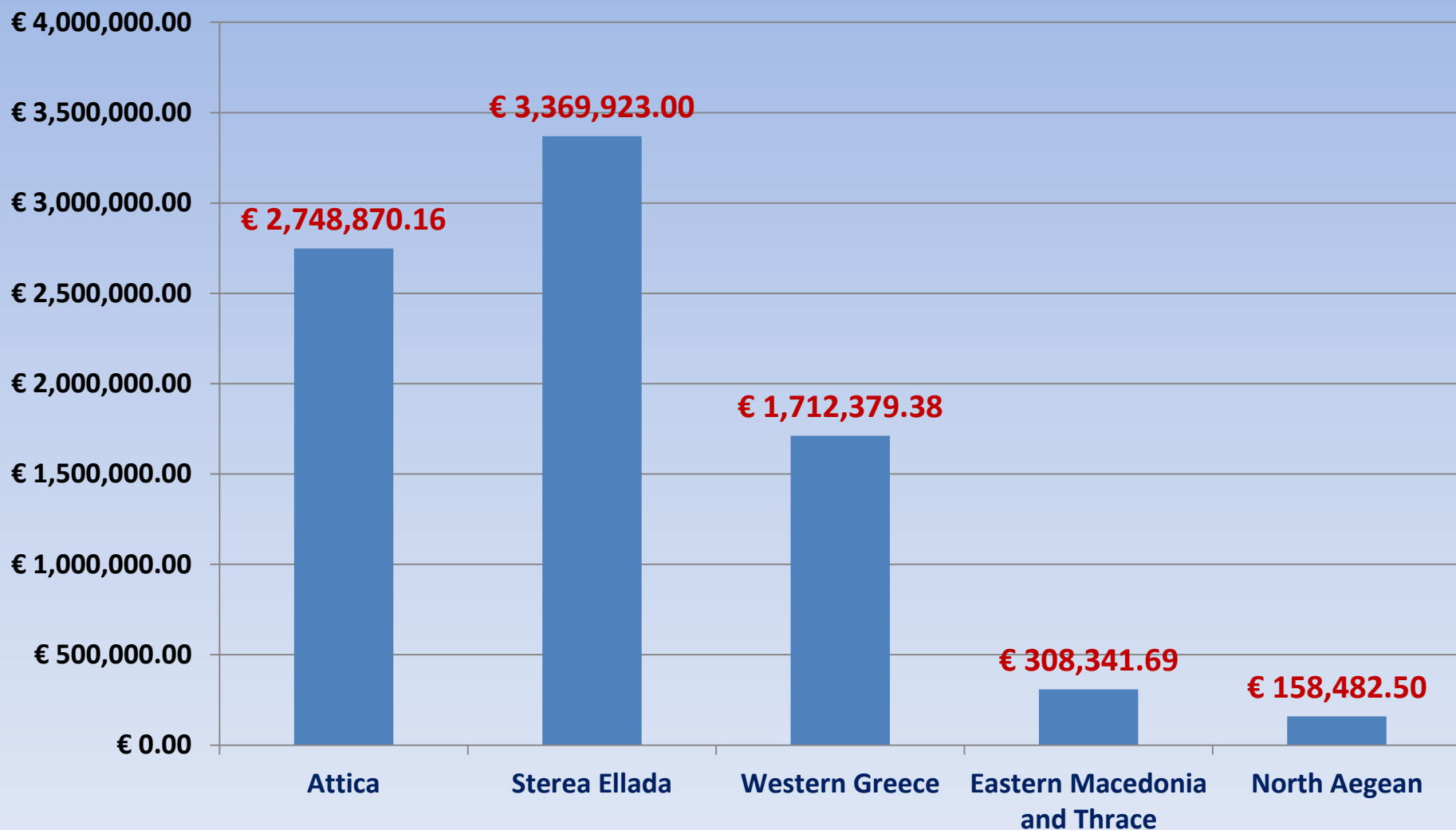


Breakdown of winners in CS 2 calls
