PRIMA in brief

- The Partnership on Research and Innovation in the Mediterranean Area (PRIMA) aims to develop much-needed solutions for a more sustainable management of water and agri-food systems in the Mediterranean basin.
- It is a ten-year initiative (2018-2028), co-funded by the EU's Framework Program for Research and Innovation, Horizon 2020 and the PRIMA participating states (PS).
- Its main objective is to devise new research and innovation approaches to improve water availability and sustainable agriculture production in a region heavily distressed by climate change, urbanization and population growth.
- 19 countries participate: Algeria, Croatia, Cyprus, Egypt, France, Germany, Greece, Israel, Italy, Jordan, Lebanon, Luxembourg, Malta, Morocco, Portugal, Slovenia, Spain, Tunisia and Turkey.
- The partnership received funding from participating countries (currently €274 million) and a €220 million contribution from the EU through Horizon 2020.

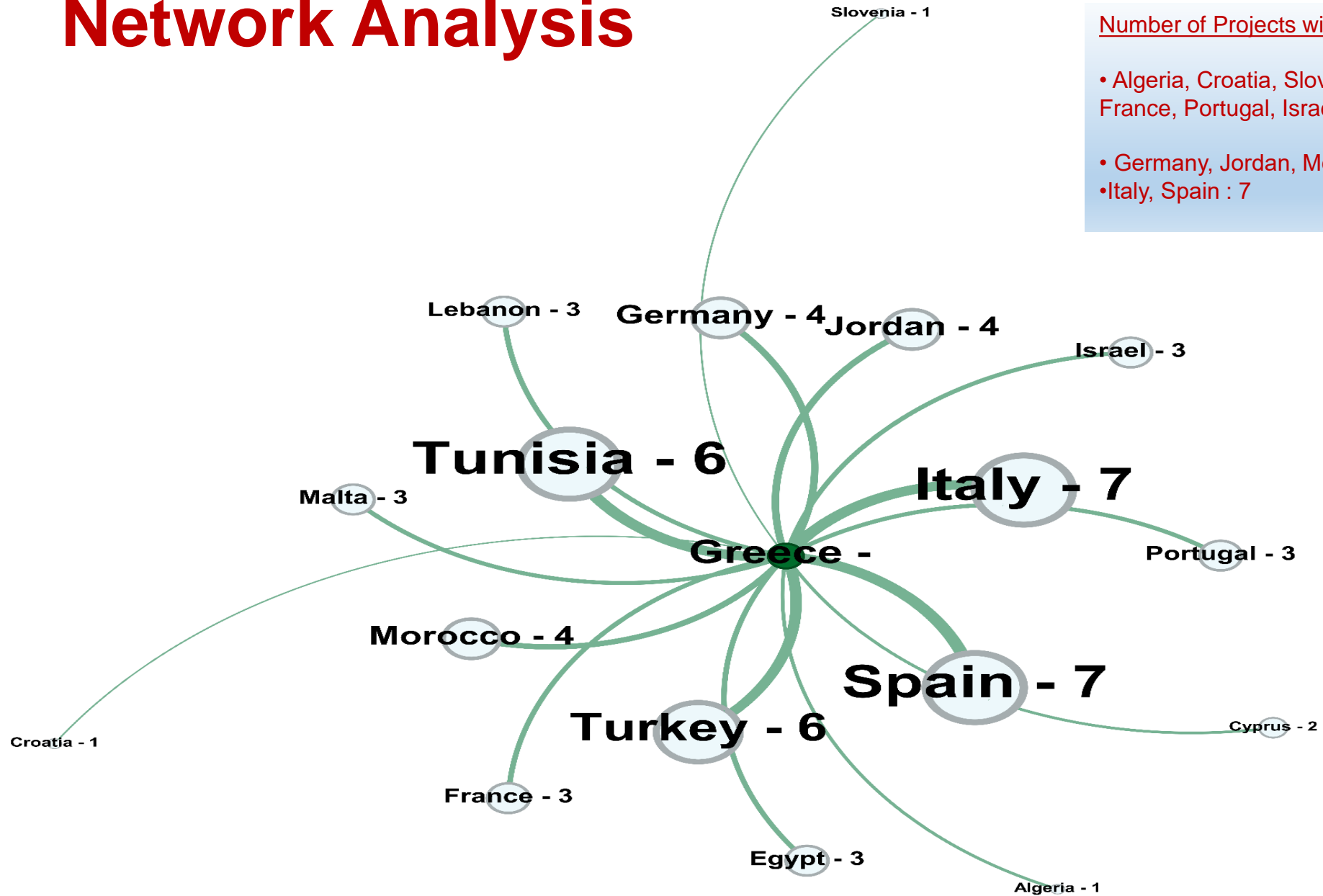

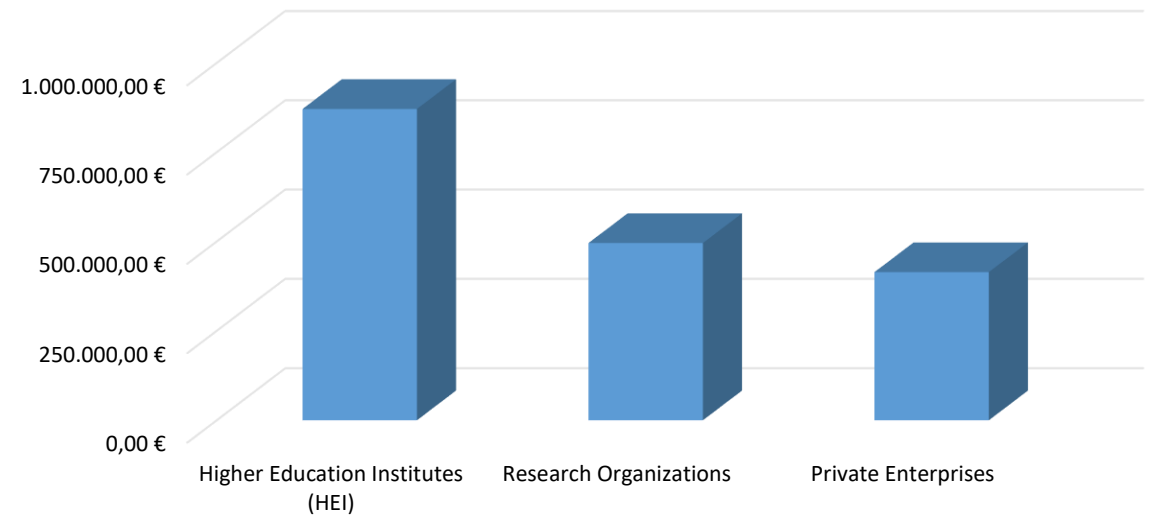

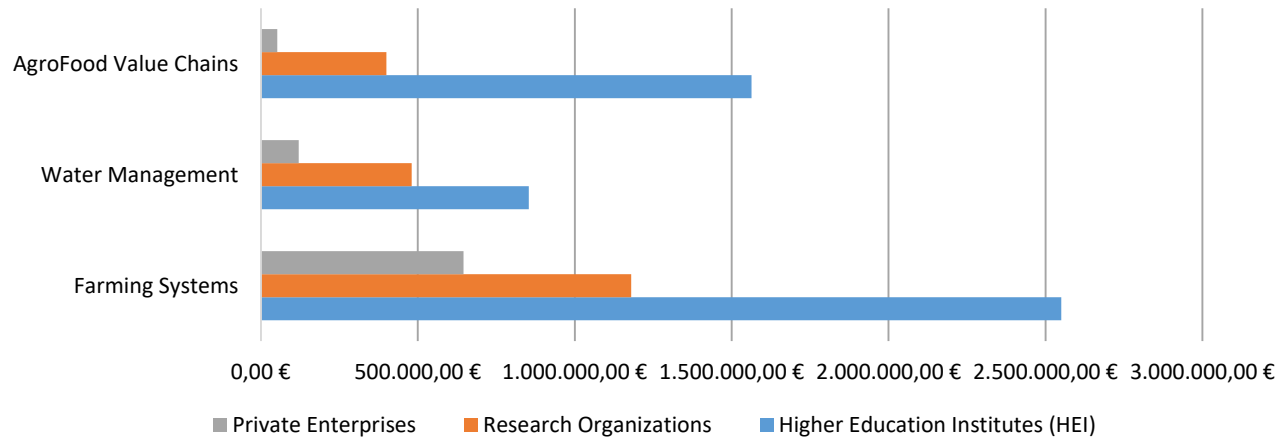

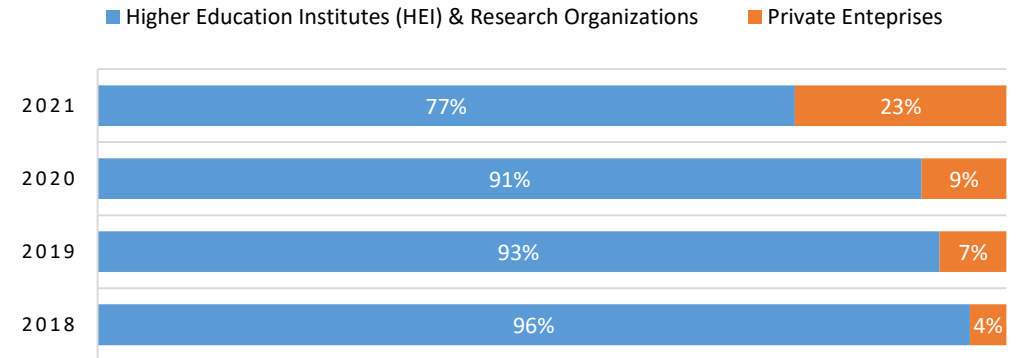

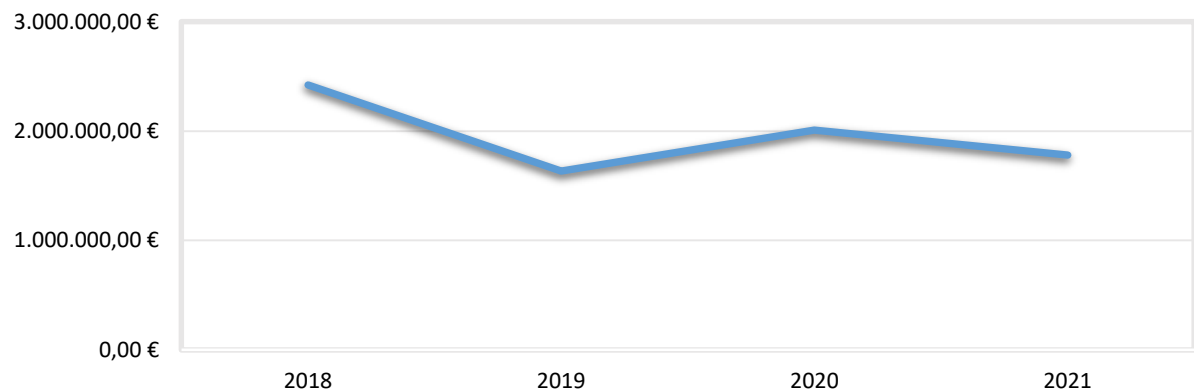


DISTRIBUTION OF BUDGET

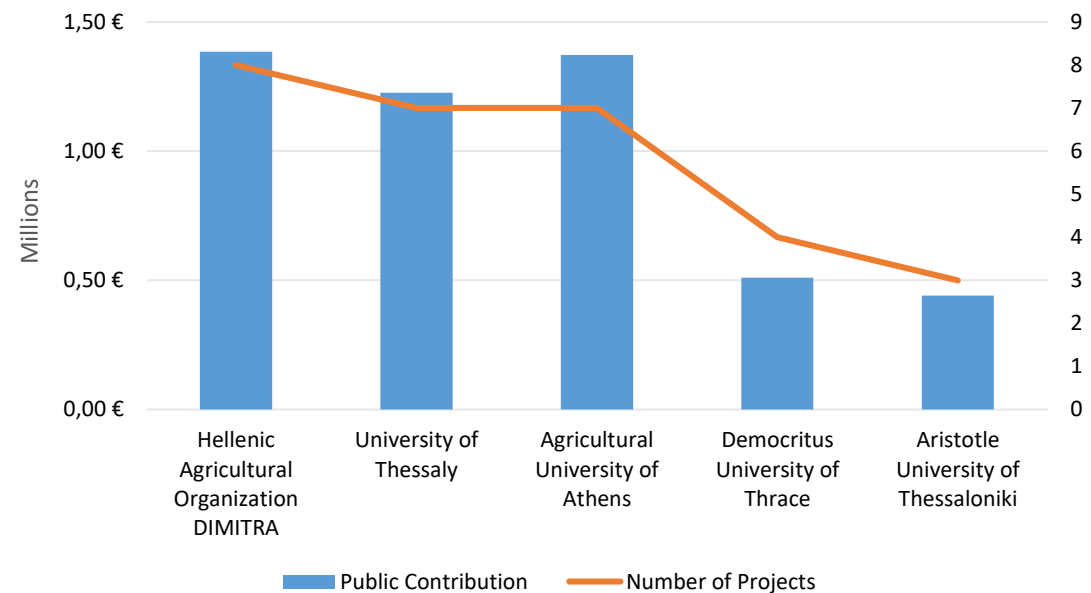

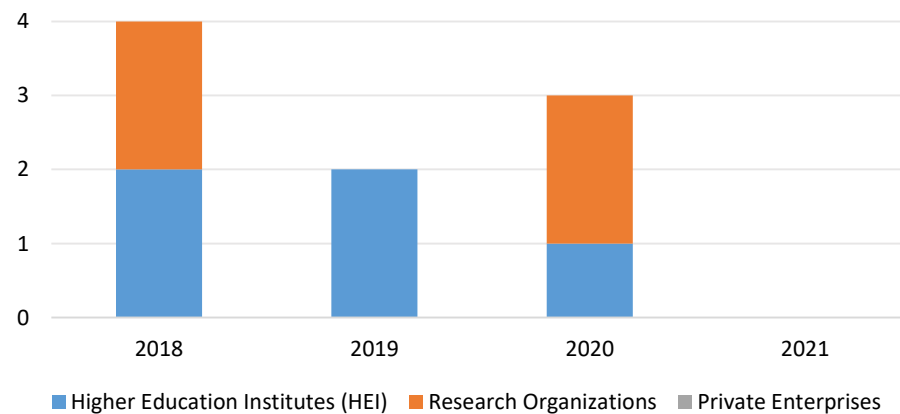
