

Zoi Rapti is Deputy Minister of Development and Member of Parliament for the Northern Sector of Athens with New Democracy.

She graduated from the Law School of the University of Athens and she received the title of Master of Laws (LLM with honors) in International Commercial Law at the University of Kent at Canterbury, Great Britain.

She is a lawyer at the Supreme Court and the Council of State and she has a 16-year experience in Local Government, where she served as:

- President of the Municipal Council,
- Deputy Mayor of the Municipality of Psychiko,

- Member of the Political Committee of the Council of European Municipalities and Regions (CEMR) of KEDE, and
- President of the Association of Municipalities for the Protection and Redevelopment of Turkovounia.

She also served as Secretary at the "Konstantinos Karamanlis" Democracy Institute, Secretary of Society-Party Relations and as a member of the Health and Labor and Social Solidarity Sectors of New Democracy.

She was elected Member of Parliament with the New Democracy in the Northern Sector of Athens in July 2019.

She was a parliamentary representative of New Democracy from 2019 to 2020.

From August 2020 to April 2023, she served as Deputy Minister of Health responsible for mental health and addictions.

She was re-elected Member of Parliament in the Northern Sector of Athens in May 2023 and she served as a parliamentary representative of New Democracy from June 2023 to June 2024.

In June 2024, she was appointed by the Prime Minister, Mr. Kyriakos Mitsotakis, as Deputy Minister of Development responsible for Research and Innovation issues, and in charge of the General Secretariat of Research and Innovation and the research and technological institutions.
