Tasos Gaitanis was born in Athens, Greece, and hails from Western Mani. He holds a PhD in Medical Physics from the Medical School of the University of Patras, a master's degree (MSc) in Medical Physics from the University of Surrey, UK, and an undergraduate degree in Biomedical Technology from the Higher Technological Educational Institution of Athens (now the University of West Attica).

Since 2003, he has been working at the Biomedical Research Foundation Academy of Athens (BRFAA). He initially served as Head of the Biomedical Technology Department and was later promoted to Staff Research Scientist B' in 2014, focusing on developing the infrastructure and operation of Preclinical PET/CT imaging. In October 2020, he was further promoted to grade A after a successful evaluation.
